- Students completing a BA degree in English are required to complete 12 hours in the same language.
- For the general electives, it is recommended that students consider taking courses from the following list: EN 331, 362, 363, 391, 455, CO 241, 342.
- Students are required to have 128 hours to graduate, including a minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses and 3 J-Terms in at least 2 departments.
