### NOTES:

- EN 121 and 151 are core curriculum requirements and are prerequisites to courses in the English department.
- Twelve hours must be taken from EN 311, 321, 337, 374, 375, 386, 387, 431, 452, 453, 454 or DM 330.
- Students completing a BA degree in English are required to complete 12 hours in the same language.
- Students are required to have 128 hours to graduate, including a minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses and 3 J-Terms in at least 2 departments.
